CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Smoke over the fire area has helped to moderate fire activity. The fire spread is driven mostly by topography and and dry vegetation. Heavy timber and steep terrain continue to complicate firefighting efforts. A Red Flag Warning has been issued for the fire area through 11:00 P.M. Saturday for hot, dry conditions and gusty winds. Firefighters continue to build and improve containments lines in more active portions of the fire, while mop-up and patrol efforts continue throuought the less active areas.
