## CURRENT SITUATION SUMMARY

Today, the Ranch Fire continued to burn through portions of grass, timber and brush in the steep terrain in north and northeastern portions of the fire area. Fire activity is expected to decrease this evening due to increased humidity and lower temperatures. Firefighters continue prepping for and executing firing operations as conditions allow. Crews will prep around structures to limit the impacts of fire spread around structures within the fireline. The southern portion of the fire remains in patrol status as crews continue with suppression repair and mop up.

The River Fire had no movement. Suppression repair along with patrol will continue on the River Fire.
