## CURRENT SITUATION

<b>Situation Summary:</b>	Today, fire crews actively engaged in rescue and firefighting operations. Fire crews continue structure defense and fire suppression in the areas with fire activity. Forecasted strong northeast winds, in combination with low relative humidity and dry fuel moistures will continue to produce extreme fire behavior including dangerous rates of spread, and long range spotting.
