Current Situation: Significant resources have been added to the fire fight with the addition of engine and crews. Crews will continue to work diligently to hold existing fire lines and expand containment while working in high temperatures and difficult terrain.

The damage assessment teams have identified 8 residential structures and 10 outbuilding destroyed by the fire.

Evacuations: All evacuations have been lifted.

Road Closures: All roads have been opened to residents only.
