Current Situation: The fire burned actively throughout the night through extremely dry fuels driven by down canyon winds. The limited access to the fire area continues to be a major challenge. Additional crews are being assigned to the firelines.

Evacuations: Mandatory evacuation orders have been issued for Big Foot Road from Platina Road to Wilson Creek (east). Advisory evacuations are issued for the area east of Wilson Creek to Rainbow Lake Road.

American Red Cross will be available for assistance.

Road Closures: Big Foot Road, north of Platina Road
