Current Situation: The fire continues to burn heavy brush and timber in higher elevations. Improved weather conditions allowed firefighters to continue to make progress.

Evacuations: Mandatory evacuation orders remain for Big Foot Road from Platina Road and Sunny Hill Road at Rainbow Lake Road. Advisory evacuations continue to be issued for the area east to Rainbow Lake Road.

Evacuation Shelter: Igo-Ono Elementary School, 6429 Placer Road, Igo
American Red Cross will be available for assistance.

Road Closures: Platina Road at Bland Road for all westbound traffic and Platina Road at Graves Ranch Road for all eastbound traffic, Sunny Hill Road at Rainbow Lake Road.

Animal Assistance: Contact Shasta County Animal Control at 530-245-6540.

Cooperating Agencies: Shasta County Fire, BLM, USFS, Shasta County Sheriff's Office, CHP, Cal OES, CDCR, CCC, Red Cross, Shasta County Animal Control, Clear Creek Community Service District and Shasta County DPW.
