**Current Situation:** The fire continues to burn heavy brush and timber in higher elevations. The increase in acreage was due to successful burning operations within the control lines. Current weather conditions allowed firefighters to make significant progress.

**Evacuations:** Mandatory evacuation orders have been lifted for Sunny Hill Road. An evacuation advisory remains in effect for the area. All other evacuation orders and advisories have been lifted.

**Evacuation Shelter:** Igo-Ono Elementary School, 6429 Placer Road, Igo  
American Red Cross will be available for assistance.

**Road Closures:** Bully Choop Road remains closed to all traffic except emergency personnel. All other roads are open.
