Current Situation: The fire continues to burn in heavy timber and brush. Firefighters are constructing control lines along the fire perimeter with the support of firefighting aircraft and bulldozers. High temperatures, low humidity and strong, erratic winds continue to pose challenges.

Watch for slow-moving firefighting equipment on the roadway in and around the fire area.

Evacuations: The Lookout Ranchettes are under a mandatory evacuation.

Road Closures: County roads 93 and 94 are closed from the intersection west.
