Current Situation: The fire is burning in heavy timber. Firefighters are challenged by steep, rugged terrain with difficult access. The fire has spread east along the Eel river canyon and moved to within 1-mile of the Big Bend Lodge area, along Low Gap creek. Firefighting personnel and equipment are actively working to construct fireline across the northern boundary of the fire.

Cooperating Agencies: Bureau of Land Management, Laytonville Fire Department, Mendocino County Sheriff's Office, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, California National Guard, California Conservation Corps, and CAL OES.
