Subject: Evacuation Order has been downgraded for some areas of the *Lodge Complex Fire*.

What: The *Evacuation Order* for some areas of the Lodge Complex Fire has been downgraded.

The following areas have been downgraded to an *Evacuation Warning*: **Camp Seabow, Bowman Ranch, Hunt Ranch, Tan Oak Park, Elk Ridge and Mad Creek.**

An *Evacuation Order* remains in effect for the areas south of Highway 101, west of Cummings Road to Leggett. These areas include **The Hermitage, Big Bend and Camp St. Michael**. We will continue to evaluate the need for the evacuation order as the incident progresses.

An, "Evacuation Warning," means there is a potential threat to life and property in the affected areas. Individuals living in these areas should have a plan and be prepared to leave.
