Current Situation:

Firefighters continue to patrol and mop up hot spots, as well as extinguish flare ups within the fire perimeter. Resources have begun to demobilize, allowing crews to be available for new incidents. The Fire Suppression Repair process continues. With the exception of Lassen National Forest, all highway closures and evacuations have been lifted.
