Current Situation: Firefighters are improving containment lines and continuing mop up and overhaul work within the fire perimeter. Damage Assessment Teams continue to survey the impacted areas of the fire. Excess resources are being released and made available for other incidents as necessary. Utility crews continue assessing and repairing damaged equipment and infrastructure. All water is now safe to drink. A Red Flag Warning remains in effect for the area.
