**Current Situation:** Firefighters continued building containment lines and improving existing containment lines throughout the night. Mop-up work continues within the fire perimeter as well. Terrain along with limited ground access continues to be a challenge to firefighters. Favorable weather conditions and limited fire behavior overnight aided Firefighters in their efforts. Damage inspection teams will continue to survey the impacted areas.
