TOTAL PERSONNEL ASSIGNED **250+****CURRENT SITUATION:**

- Residents may see smoking debris on hillsides but it does not pose a threat to residents and structures
- The Community of Paradise may be re-populated today early afternoon if infrastructure needs are met
- Swall Meadow re-population late afternoon after Paradise, if infrastructure needs are met
- 42 degrees, 46% humidity NNW 8 mph
- Media is in the area and under California Penal Code 409.5 SS D, they are allowed access to into fire damaged areas even when residents are not. However, they are not allowed onto private property without permission from the homeowner.
- Details of re-population plan and directions will be forthcoming by noon
- There has been no loss of life to date recorded/reported per Sheriff/Coroner Ingrid Braun
