CURRENT SITUATION:

- Smoking debris may be seen on the western edge of the fire but do not pose a threat to residents.
- Repopulation for Paradise and Swall Meadows residents began Monday at 4 p.m.
- Residents of Paradise and Swall Meadows will need a valid form of identification. Residents must obtain an access pass from the Mono County Sheriff Department staged near the entry point located on the North side of Pine Creek, East of Lower Rock Creek.
- Residents will need to use extreme caution in and around damaged and destroyed homes. Structural instability, hot ash pockets, and fire weaken chimneys pose a risk for injury. Remember to use gloves and a dust mask when working around fire debris.
