CURRENT SITUATION:

- Smoking debris may be seen on the western edge of the fire but do not pose a threat to residents.
- Repopulation for Paradise and Swall Meadows residents began Monday at 4 p.m.
- Residents Swall Meadows will need a valid form of identification. Residents must obtain an access pass from the Mono County Sheriff Department at Lower Rock Creek just north of the Paradise Fire Station.
- Residents will need to use extreme caution in and around damaged and destroyed homes. Structural instability, hot ash pockets, and fire weaken chimneys pose a risk for injury. Hazardous chemicals may remain in the ash and soil.
