Cause: Under Investigation

Current Situation: Fire burning at a moderate rate of spread. There continues to be a threat to the North Fork community. Access to the fire is difficult due to steep terrain. Firefighters are experiencing extreme fire behavior conditions due to drought and low fuel moisture.

Evacuations: **Evacuation order for residents south of Corrin Road to Kerckoff Lake**
Evacuation advisory for the community of Cascadel

Residents should remain cautious of fire personnel and equipment working in the area.

Road Closures: **Road 222 from Road 200 to Corrine Lake Rd**
Road 225 between Road 235 and 233

Evacuation Centers: **Sierra Presbyterian Church, 39696 Highway 41 in Oakhurst**

Cooperating Agencies: CAL FIRE, USFS, Madera County Fire Department, Madera County Sheriff's Department, PG&E, Red Cross, CHP and additional resources from the central valley.
