Current Situation

Overview: Firefighting crews worked through the night to increase containment lines on the "SKY" vegetation fire that started on Mix Canyon Road in Solano County. The vegetation fire is approximately 150 acres and 60% contained. Crews continue to focus on hand line construction and perimeter control. Challenges include: difficult access, gusty winds and steep terrain. No structures have been damaged or destroyed. Mix Canyon Road is closed to thru traffic. While the vegetation fire was ignited by a vehicle fire, the cause of the vehicle fire is under investigation.
