Current Situation

Overview: **Firefighters at aggressively working a 700 acre vegetation fire at Hwy 128 X Wragg in Napa County, near Lake Berryessa. The fire is traveling at a rapid rate of spread. The terrain is brush covered, rugged and steep, with difficult access. Winds are erratic. Fire crews and air resources are working on perimeter control and containment. Structures are threatened in the Mix Canyon Area. Road closure at Hwy 128 and Wragg Canyon to through traffic. Hikers in the Cold Canyon Area will be evacuated.**
