Current Situation

Overview: Firefighters aggressively working a 1000 acre vegetation fire at Hwy 128 X Wragg in Napa County, near Lake Berryessa. The fire is traveling at a rapid rate of spread. The terrain is brush covered, rugged and steep, with difficult access. Winds are erratic. Fire crews and air resources are working on perimeter control and containment. 150 structures threatened in the Quail Ridge Community. Road closure at Hwy 128 and Wragg Canyon to through traffic. RED CROSS has opened an Evacuation Center at the Winters Community Center, 201 Railroad Ave, Winters, CA.
