Current Situation

Overview: Firefighting personnel continue to aggressively work in treacherous terrain, providing structure defense and improving containment lines. The wildland fire increased in size during the evening. The terrain is brush covered, rugged and steep, with difficult access. Winds are erratic. Additional resources have been ordered. 200 structures threatened in the Quail Ridge Community. Road closure at Hwy 128 and Wragg Canyon to through traffic. RED CROSS has opened an Evacuation Center at the Winters Community Center, 201 Railroad Ave, Winters, CA. A large animal evacuation center is opened at 29775 County Road 31, Winters, CA. Incident Command Team 6 will assume management of the incident at 1800 today.
