#### Current Situation

**Overview:** Firefighting personnel continue to aggressively work in treacherous terrain, providing structure defense and improving containment lines. The terrain is brush covered, rugged and steep, with difficult access. Winds have increased this afternoon, with gusts, creating challenges with the fire spotting. Additional resources have been ordered. 200 structures threatened in the Quail Ridge Community. Road closure at Hwy 128 and Wragg Canyon to through traffic. RED CROSS has opened an Evacuation Center at the Winters Community Center, 201 Railroad Ave, Winters, CA. A large animal evacuation center is opened at 29775 County Road 31, Winters, CA. Structure threat has been diminished north of Hwy 128.

**Evacuations:** Quail Ridge and Golden Bear Communities under mandatory evacuations. Canyon Creek and Lake Solano Campgrounds have been evacuated. Hikers in Cold Canyon Area have been evacuated.

**Road Closures:** Hwy 128 from Wragg Canyon to Pleasant Valley will remain closed today.
