Current Situation

Overview: Highway 128 remains open. Evacuations remain in place for Quail Canyon and Sackett Lane. Canyon Creek area has been repopulated. The fire is located in an area with steep and rugged terrain, some of which is inaccessible. Fire crews continue to make progress and construct line around the fire. The RED CROSS Evacuation Center at the Winters Community Center is now closed. A large animal evacuation center remains open at 29775 County Road 31, Winters, CA.
