Evacuations:	None
Road Closures:	There are no current or expected road closures.
Additional Information:	A damage inspection has been completed. A water supply wellhead and other minor structures were damaged. A walnut orchard sustained damage and two vehicles were destroyed. Dozers and hand crews continue to construct fire line in steep and rugged terrain. The change in total acreage is due to more accurate mapping of the fire.
