Current Situation:	The fire intensity increased on the south side of the Wragg Fire on 7/28/15 increasing the acres burned. The forward progress of this fire activity has been stopped. The fire stayed within the control objectives and within the secondary containment lines. Due to triple digit temperatures and single digit relative humidity this fire continues to have the potential to expand. Evacuations:	Mandatory Evacuations have been ordered for Mix Canyon, Sky Ranch Road, Wild Horse Canyon Rd., and Blue Ridge Road. (Approximately 136 homes /200 residents) An evacuation center is established at Ulatis Community Center located at 1000 Ulatis Dr. in Vacaville. (707 469-4000) An evacuation advisory has been issued for Gates Canyon Road and the area west of Pleasants Valley Road. It is a high priority to lift evacuation orders and open roads when it is safe to do so.
Road Closures:	Pleasants Valley Road is open to all traffic. Mix Canyon Road is closed at Pleasants Valley Road. Gates Canyon Road is open only to residents with identification at Pleasants Valley Road.
Additional Information:	Lake Solano campground is currently closed due to fire equipment access. In all areas (including evacuated areas) residents with large animals are allowed to retrieve them to move to a safe area.
