Current Situation: The fire continues to smolder and creep in heavy timber areas. Firefighters are engaging in mop up operations as access to some parts are still very challenging. Smoke may continue to impact the fire area and the surrounding communities.

Evacuations: Evacuation advisories are in effect for the Steep Hollow Creek Community, from Chalk Bluff Road to Banner Quaker Road and the Buckeye Ridge Community. All other evacuation orders have been lifted. The public is asked to stay vigilant to any changes of evacuation areas.

The Tahoe National Forest is maintaining a forest closure with specified exemptions for the fire area.

Road Closures: Nevada County: Red Dog Road at Chalk Bluff Road, Red Dog Road at Buckeye Ridge Road, Banner Quaker at Lower Greenhorn Road, Banner Quaker at Chalk Bluff, & Lowell Hill Road at Mule Spring Road.

Placer County: Secret Town at Chicago Park Power House Road & Diggin Road at Main Street in Dutch Flat.
