Current Situation: The fire continues to smolder and creep in heavy timber areas as firefighters engage in mop up operations. Heavier fuels continue to consume well inside the containment lines as a modest cooling trend is moving in.

Evacuations: All evacuation advisories and orders have been lifted. The public is urged to use extreme caution as firefighters and equipment continue to work in the fire areas and surrounding communities.
