Current Situation:	Firefighters were quickly demobilized from the Rocky Fire to the new Jerusalem Fire. The Rocky Fire containment continues to grow and you may see several small flare ups within the interior. Access to the fire line continues to be challenging in various parts of the fire. Damage assessment has been completed and firefighters continue to establish and construct containment lines and implement the suppression repair plan. RESIDENTS ARE URGED TO STAY VIGILANT AND ADHERE TO ANY CHANGES IN EVACUATIONS AND ROAD CLOSURES ". Fire activity and direction can change at any time, be prepared and stay informed.
