**Current Situation:** Crews continue lengthening and strengthening containment lines around the fire and will remain on scene until the fire is completely out. Motorists driving in the area of the fire on Highway 120, especially after dark, are asked to exercise great caution to avoid fire equipment and crews.

**Evacuations:** Lifted at 6 p.m. 7-30-15, and residents were allowed to return to their homes.
