Current Situation: The fire that threatened structures in the Blocksburg areas has been mitigated. Firelines are currently holding and being reinforced. A total of 8 fires over 100 acres have burned 3,192 acres. Active fires range in size from 142 to 749 acres. Threat continues to commercial timberland. Much of the timberland is owned by small timberland and rangeland owners. Who rely on timber and range revenue for a steady source of income.

Evacuations: The advisory evacuation for the community of Blocksburg was lifted at 6:00 p.m. Monday August 3, 2015.

Road Closures: Highway 36 is closed from the Humboldt/Trinity county line to 3.5 miles west of the Trinity/Shasta county line.
