SITUATION

Current Situation:	<p>There are still isolated pockets of smoldering fuel producing large amounts of heat and continue to pose a risk of spotting outside the fire perimeter. Resources will continue to mop up hot spots and patrol the line for several days. Maintain awareness as fire crews and emergency vehicles continue to work in the area. As you re-enter your property and evaluate damage, be aware that hazardous conditions may exist, particularly if a residence or out-building has burned. If you see electrical wires on the ground, stay clear and contact PG&E immediately.</p> <p>“RESIDENTS ARE URGED TO STAY VIGILANT AND ADHERE TO ANY CHANGES IN EVACUATIONS AND ROAD CLOSURES”. Fire activity and direction can change at any time, be prepared and stay informed. With the elevated fire danger, we are asking everyone to use extreme caution, “Ready, Set, Go”.
