### Current Situation

#### Overview:

Good progress was made throughout the day on the Elk fire. CALFIRE and the United States Forest Service (USFS) are in Unified Command of the incident located off Elk Mountain Road in the community of Upper Lake in Lake County. The Elk Incident remains at 670 acres but the containment has increased to 30% as of 6:00 PM this evening. Firefighters at scene continue to build and improve fire lines as well as mopping up hot spots near the line. Crews will continue working through the night and labor day weekend so motorist should use caution in the area.
