Current Situation

Firefighters were able to build and strengthen control lines throughout the night. The fire continues to burn in steep and rugged terrain, however favorable weather conditions are expected to assist fire suppression efforts today. Homes in the area of Ponderosa Way between Lower Forbestown Rd. and the Ponderosa Reservoir and Broken Springs Rd. remain under an *Immediate Evacuation Order*. *Evacuation Warnings* remain in effect for homes located in the areas of Forbestown Rd. to New York flats, and Lumpkin Rd. to the Enterprise Boat Launch. Road closures remain in effect for Ponderosa Way from lower Forbestown Rd. to the Ponderosa Reservoir/South Fork Feather River.
