Firefighters were able to take advantage of favorable weather conditions today and made considerable progress. All evacuation orders and warnings for the incident have been lifted. Ponderosa Way is open to local traffic only, from Lower Forbestown Rd to the Ponderosa Reservoir/S. Fork Feather River.
