SITUATION				
<b>Current Situation:</b>	<p>Fire behavior was moderated overnight due to cooler weather and rainy conditions. Over one-half inch of rain fell over portions of the fire yesterday. The rain assisted firefighters in strengthening and constructing additional fire lines. However, a warming trend is expected over the next few days with temperatures exceeding 90 degrees over the weekend. 585 homes have been destroyed by the Valley Fire and hundreds of other structures are known to have been damaged and or destroyed as well.</p> <p>Damage Inspection Teams continue to gather information in the affected area. As access improves and additional information becomes available, the numbers of damaged or destroyed structures will change. The inspection process is meticulous and ongoing.</p> <p><b>*** Damage Assessment teams continue to collect information in the affected fire areas as access becomes available***</b></p>
