| <b>Current Situation:</b>  | Crews continue to make good progress on the Valley Fire. Tomorrow, residents in the Communities of Hidden Valley Lake, Jerusalem Grade, Grange Road, and Butts Canyon Road will be allowed to return to their homes at noon. Access to these areas will be available for residents only. Hidden Valley Lake will only be accessible through the Hartmann Road entrance. The cancellation of additional evacuation orders are being evaluated based on a variety of factors including potential fire behavior and re-establishment of critical infrastructure. Damage Inspection Teams continued today gathering damage data in the affected areas. As additional information becomes available, the numbers of damaged or destroyed structures may change. |                              |                             |                |
