SITUATION

Current Situation:	<p>Firefighters will continue to improve existing lines and mop up hot spots across the fire area in the coming days. Rehabilitation is underway to restore the natural landscape that may have been altered during initial firefighting efforts.</p> <p>Damage Inspection Teams have completed primary and secondary assessments of the structures destroyed by the Valley Fire. A total of 1958 structures have been destroyed including; 1280 homes, 27 multi-family structures, 66 commercial properties, and 585 other minor structures such as outbuildings and sheds.</p> <p>93 structures have been damaged including; 41 homes, 7 commercial properties, and 45 other minor structures.</p> <p>At 10:00 today, CAL FIRE Incident Management Team 3 will transition command of the Valley Fire to the Sonoma-Lake-Napa Unit of CAL FIRE.
