SITUATION				
Current Situation:	The stronger onshore flow will bring much needed relief to the Tassajara Fire area this evening. The weather will be mild over the next few days with high humidity's in the evening's, however it will remain dry and windy during the day. Temperatures will rise and humidity's will lower later in the week. Firefighters will continue to mop up and patrol, making sure hot spots are mitigated and control lines are strengthened. The Oak woodland, with dead understory, as well as the heavy brush created extreme fire behavior during this fire. The Laureles Fire is 95 acres and 100% contained.			
Evacuations:	An Evacuation Order still remains in effect within the fire perimeter on Tassajara Road, Cachagua Road			
Evacuation Centers:				
Road Closures:	Cachaqua Road at Madrone Road, Poppy Tree Lane at Buckeye Road, Tassajara Road, east of Buckeye Road (Tassajara Road closed at fire perimeter to north traffic), Tassajara Road, south of East Carmel Valley Road (Tassajara Road closed at fire perimeter to south traffic) and East Carmel Valley Road, south of Tassajara Road near fire perimeter will have one-lane traffic control due to fire equipment operating in the area.
