<b>Current Situation:</b>	<p>CAL FIRE Incident Management Team #1 will transition the fire back over to Kern County tomorrow morning.</p> <p>Suppression repair activities continue and firefighters will be working overnight to construct containment lines while strengthening and securing control lines.</p> <p>Residents need to be prepared for this fire season.
