Current Situation:

Firefighters made progress through the night gaining some containment, however the steep terrain and increase winds in the evening posed a challenge in some areas of the fire. Today crews will continue direct line construction on both sides of Hwy 198.

Evacuation Warnings for the following area:

Highway 198 from Coalinga City limits to the Monterey-Fresno county line as well as 3 miles south of Highway 198 at Parkfield Grade.

Road Closures:

SR198 is closed from 1.1 miles east of the junction of SR25 (Monterey Co) to Firestone Avenue in Coalinga (Fresno Co)
