Current Situation:	<p>Firefighters made good progress on their initial attack as well as throughout the night in very difficult terrain. Firefighters will continue to construct containment line around the perimeter of the fire and to reinforce existing line during the course of this afternoon and tonight.</p> <p>Highway 198 will be open to all traffic as of 8:00 PM today. Fire equipment will be working along Highway 198 for the next few days so we ask that you drive slowly and safely within this area.</p> <p>There have been over 300 wildfires this week alone, throughout California. With the holiday weekend upon us we ask that you be aware of your surroundings for "One Less Spark" will prevent "One Less Wildfire".</p>			
Evacuations:	<p><b>Evacuation Warnings:</b> Highway 198 from Coalinga City limits to the Monterey – Fresno County line as well as 3 miles south of Highway 198 at the Parkfield Grade.</p>

Road Closures:	<p>The road closures on State Route 198 from 1.1 miles east of the junction of State Route 25 (Monterey County) to Firestone Avenue in Coalinga (Fresno County) <b>will be lifted at 8:00 PM today for all traffic.</b></p>
