Mandatory Evacuation Orders Expand on Soberanes Fire

Monterey County – *The Monterey County Sheriff's Department has expanded the mandatory evacuation order to include Rocky Creek and Old Coast Road, Bixby Creek Road from Highway 1 south to Middle Road. All residents are required to evacuate the designated area immediately.*

Evacuation advisories remain in place for Carmel Highlands, Rancho San Carlos, White Rock and Rancho San Clemente.

All residents are asked to be READY: Create and maintain defensible space and harden your home against flying embers. Get SET: Prepare your family and home ahead of time for the possibility of having to evacuate. Be Ready to GO! Take the evacuation steps necessary to give your family and home the best chance of surviving a wildfire.

Residents should be prepared to leave the area immediately if a Voluntary or Mandatory Evacuation Order is issued. If you evacuate be sure to take any medications, pets, family valuables etc. with you, close all windows including window coverings, and leave all doors closed. A temporary shelter facility has been established at the Carmel Middle School 4380 Carmel Valley Road. For further information dial 2-1-1.
