SOBERANES FIRE: EVACUATIONS ORDERS LIFTED

The Monterey County Sheriff's Office is REPOPULATING the area of GARRAPATA TROUT FARM RD AND WESTON RIDGE RD.

- **LIFTED:** Garrapata Trout Farm Rd. and Weston Ridge Rd. (aka Garrapata Ridge Rd) excluding the driveway N. of Trout Farm Rd.
- **ORDER:** Palo Colorado Rd. and the driveway N. of Garrapata Trout Farm Rd. continues to be under an evacuation order.

SAFETY MESSAGE – The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. Please continue to adhere to road closures and any evacuation orders or warnings. If you see electrical wires on the ground, stay clear and contact PG&E immediately. Trees and poles with deep charring, particularly if still smoking, should be considered hazardous. Please drive slowly and yield to emergency personnel in the area.

As you re-enter your property and evaluate damage, be aware that hazardous conditions may exist, particularly if a residence or out-building has burned. Hazards may include asbestos, heavy metals, by-products of plastic combustion and various other chemicals.
