| SITUATION | | | |
| Current Situation: | The Pilot Fire is burning in chaparral and brush in between Pilot Rock Ridge and State Highway 173 in Hesperia and continues to be mostly wind driven. Fire line has been constructed in the Summit Valley area. Crews are continuing to construct dozer line from Pilot Rock to the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District Wastewater Treatment Plant. Aircraft are being used to the extent possible. Firefighters made significant progress over the last 24 hours. Terrain, heat, and wind continue to hinder firefighters efforts. | | |
| Weather Conditions: | Tonight's weather on the fire area will continue to be critical with low humidity and winds from the south gusting to 25 mph. Overnight temperatures will cool to the middle 60s with poor humidity recovery. Thursday's weather will bring another day of south winds of 10-15 mph, with gusts to 30 mph in the afternoon. Moisture will remain in the teens through the morning, but increasing to 20% by late afternoon. | | |
