SITUATION			
Current Situation:	<p>The Pilot Fire is burning in chaparral and brush between Pilot Rock Ridge and State Highway 173 in Hesperia and continues to be mostly wind driven. There was minimal fire activity during the night. Firefighters made significant progress over the last 48 hours. Terrain, heat, and wind continue to challenge the efforts of the firefighters.</p>		
Weather Conditions:	<p>Overnight temperatures cooled into the middle 60s with moderate to good humidity recovery. Today will begin a warming trend that will persist into next week. Temperatures will top out in the 85 to 90-degree range Friday, increasing into the low 90s for the weekend. Relative humidity values Friday, and into the first part of next week, will fall to around 15% in the afternoon, recovering to around 30% overnight.</p>
