Current Situation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Pilot Fire is burning in chaparral and brush between Pilot Rock Ridge and State Highway 173 in Hesperia. Firefighters made significant progress over the last 72 hours and will continue to work within the fire area to assure any remaining fire does not escape existing containment lines. 		
Weather Conditions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperatures will be in the 90-degree range today across the Pilot Fire. Humidity values will range between 10% - 15% in the afternoon. Winds are expected to remain in the 10-15 mph range today with a few higher gusts to 20 mph. However, a return to gusty southwest winds arrives Sunday and persists into next week.

Trail Closure:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Pacific Crest Trail is CLOSED from the Deep Creek Hot Springs (3W02) to Silverwood State Park.• The Pinnacles Trail 3W16 is closed off Highway 173.
