<b>Current Situation:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crews have made significant progress on the fire and are currently in the mop-up stage. Firefighters will continue to work within the fire area to assure any remaining fire does not escape existing containment lines. Fireline repair is underway and will continue for the next several days.</li> </ul>		
<b>Weather Conditions:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Temperatures will be in the 95-100 degree range today across the Pilot Fire. Humidity values will fall to around 15% in the afternoon. Winds are expected to be out of the southwest around 15 mph. with gusts to 35 mph on the ridgetops.</li> </ul>

<b>Evacuations:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All evacuations have been lifted.</li> <li>• Because firefighters continue to work in the area, please drive with caution and be alert to your surroundings.</li> </ul>
<b>Road Closure:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highway 173 between Grass Valley Rd. and Rock Camp</li> <li>• Forest Service Roads 2N33, 2N17X, 2N36, 2N37</li> </ul>
<b>Trail Closure:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Pacific Crest Trail is CLOSED from the Deep Creek Hot Springs (3W02) to Silverwood State Park.</li> <li>• The Pinnacles Trail 3W16 is closed off Highway 173.</li> </ul>
