Current Situation: Fire behavior was active through the day with multiple uphill runs through brush, rocks, and steep terrain. High temperatures and low humidity continued today and access to the fire is very challenging. Hundreds of firefighters are actively battling the fire from the air and on the ground.

Evacuations: Evacuation order is in place for Coalinga Mineral Springs Road.

An evacuation warning is in place for residents in the Los Gatos Canyon area. Also, the Monterey County line to Derrick.

Red Cross Evacuation Center has been set up at West Hills College 300 Cherry Lane, Coalinga, CA.

Road Closures: Highway 198 is closed at Alcalde Road in Coalinga and at the Fresno/Monterey County line.
