## **RE-POPULATION AND EVACUATION ORDER UPDATE**

### **Repopulation Issues**

- The county roads and utility companies are working to make the area safe.
- We are doing everything we can to accommodate evacuees and assisting them back into their homes as soon possible.

### **Repopulation Effective Thursday, August 12, 2016 at 7 P.M.:**

The evacuation order for Coalinga Mineral Springs Road has been lifted but will only be accessible to residents only. Residents will be required to show proper identification to access Coalinga Mineral Springs Road.

### **SAFETY MESSAGE**

The public is reminded to stay vigilant on current fire conditions. If you see electrical wires on the ground, stay clear and contact PG&E at (800) 743-5000 immediately. Trees and poles with deep charring, particularly if still smoking, should be considered hazardous. Please drive slowly as emergency personnel are in the area. Subject to change based on operational conditions.

As you re-enter your property and evaluate damage, be aware that hazardous conditions may exist, particularly if a residence or out-building has burned. Hazards may include asbestos, heavy metals, by products or plastic combustion and various other chemicals.
