Current Situation:	Today, firefighters continued to make progress towards full containment of the fire. Fire crews will remain throughout the fire perimeter in the coming weeks to provide fire suppression repair, remove firefighting equipment, mop up and patrol. Please drive slowly and use caution as emergency crews and equipment are still working in the area. CAL FIRE urges those that see significant smoke to call 9-1-1. As fires continue to threaten our communities, resources are being effectively appropriated to battle wildland fires across the State of California. CAL FIRE Incident Management Team #2 appreciates all the community support in battling the Chimney Fire.
